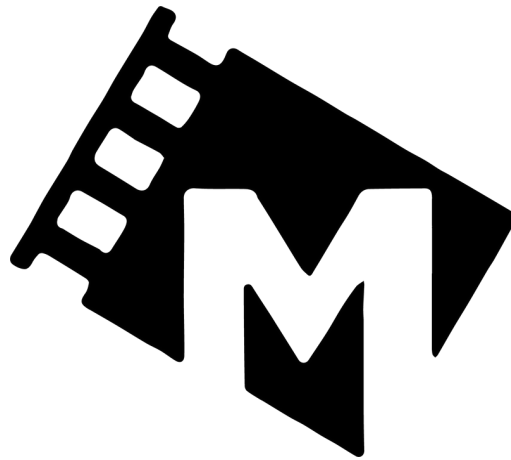

THE ECONOMIC TRANSCRIPT**TET****The Economic Transcript (TET)**

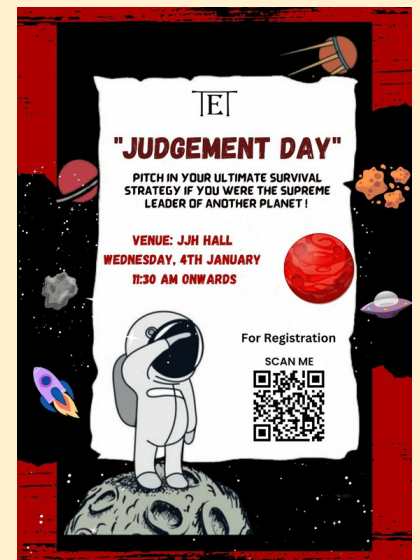

“Polaroid Friday” was conducted on 9th December, 2022 to paint students' happy memories within an hour based on Reclamo'23 theme - Hedging Happiness.

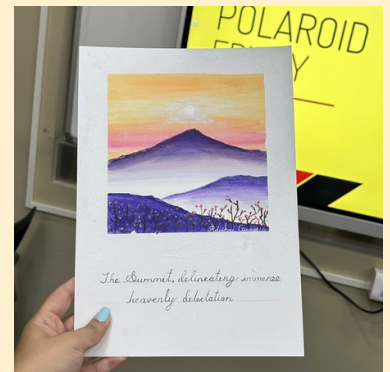
“Vyapari’s Meet” was conducted on 12th December, 2022 to foster a supportive and healthy environment for budding entrepreneurs of Mithibai.

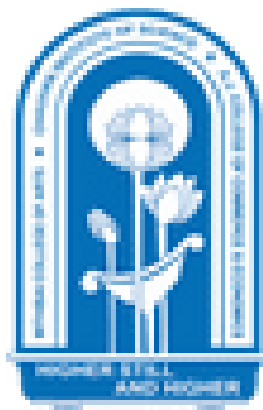
